Dr. Marx studied Family Medicine in Toledo, Ohio completing a that residency before moving to Geisinger Medical Center in Danville to complete a second residency in Emergency Medicine. Dr. Marx has worked in Emergency Medicine for 28 years, working at a variety of hospitals including busy community hospital in Chambersburg, to level 2 trauma center in Scranton, Altoona, and Camp Hill and most recently at a small critical access hospital in Fulton County. Dr. Marx worked on the frontline of medicine in the COVID pandemic from the very early days. It was during this past year that he made a complete paradigm change to prioritize early treatment using Ivermectin, Hydroxychloroquine and many vitamins and minerals to boost natural immunity. It was this decision brought conflict with the institutional powers of medicine and his story today.
